Students and Colleges Sunday

Students and Colleges Sunday is an opportunity for congregations to encourage those whom Christ is calling to the ministry.

Individuals discern Christ's call within Christian community. This is true of the primary Christian vocation—to be in relationship with God through Christ—as it is of the secondary Christian vocation—the exercise of our God-given gifts in service to God.

Many Christians exercise their Christian vocation "in the world," while serving as volunteers within the church's ministries. Still others are called to exercise their Christian vocation in full-time or part-time employed service within the church's ministries.

The Presbyterian Church in Canada assigns special responsibility to sessions and presbyteries "to make diligent and careful inquiry" whether any men and women should be directed to Christ's claims upon them with respect to the church's ministry, and to aid, encourage and guide them (Book of Forms, 202).

To assist the church with these responsibilities, the General Assembly in 2008 designated the third Sunday of October as Students and Colleges Sunday. A special bulletin prepared by one of the church's theological colleges is available through the Resource Centre, as is a brochure "Am I Being Called?" Also, the colleges may be contacted directly to request a guest speaker or worship leader. We pray for Dianne Douglas who is a member of St Mark's church family who is a student at Knox College.
